


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University Profile

Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University has been established through an Act of J&K Legislature as an autonomous, fully residential and technical University of excellence with major grants and continuing support from Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board, Katra and University Grants Commission.

The University is recognized as State University under section 2(f) and 12(B) of University Grants Commission, Govt. of India. The University has witnessed a remarkable growth and has transformed 470 acres of barren land in the lap of Trikuta hills, the abode of Shri Mata Vaishno Devi, into a magnificent "Temple of Learning". The academic system, syllabi and evaluation procedure has been adopted from Indian Institutes of Technology. The University has signed Memorandum of Understanding with various national and international academic, professional and research institutes as well as industry to augment the learning process and to develop research and development infrastructure.

The University has four Faculties consisting of twelve Schools which promote five Undergraduate and nine Postgraduate programmes besides Ph.D. and Post - doctoral Research.

The University has had the unique distinction of being inaugurated by the President of India in the year 2004. The 1st & 3rd Convocations of the University held in the year 2008 & 2011 respectively were addressed by the Prime Minister and the President of India. The 4th Convocation held on 8th February, 2014 was addressed by the Vice-President of India.

Being a fully residential university, the campus provides comfortable single, double and triple seated accommodation to all the students. There are sufficient in-door and out-door sports facilities available to the residents. The state of the Art Auditorium with seating capacity of 1000 is an excellent center for academic, cultural and social functions. Different forums and clubs like Music, Dance, Drama, Quiz, Adventure, Mind-meet forum etc. help students to utilize their spare time in a more creative and innovative way. The Officer's Club takes care of the recreation facilities for the faculty and staff. The campus provides an ideal atmosphere for healthy interactions and


CONTEXT

The University is located on 470 acres of land in the lap of Trikuta Hills, the abode of Shri Mata Vaishno Devi at about 2700 feet above the sea level. The pyramidal type architecture merges beautifully with the valley like ambience of the surrounding serene hills. The surrounding green hills and the perennial stream of Jhajjar in the east minimize the effects of hot and cold winds and produce a pollution free atmosphere on the campus. The average day temperature in summer is around 35° to 40° Celsius lesser than the surrounding areas of Jammu region and the maximum and minimum temperatures in winter are about 14° and 5° Celsius respectively. A moderately high hill full of vegetation on the Western side of the campus shields the campus, particularly the residential zone, from the long summer afternoons. The slight incline of the campus provides an ideal place for endurance exercises the spiritual influence of the Divine Mother and Holy Shrine is palpable on the campus, which helps add spiritual dimension to the quality of education and life on the campus. An early morning and late evening walk, along the Shrine Axis and other loop roads, surrounded by evenly placed lovely trees and clear sky with sparkling stars, refreshes body, mind and the soul.

The University is located close to centers of commerce but at the same time is sufficiently away from the maddening crowds of the major cities, which can distract students. The activities on the campus are designed to provide ample scope for interaction between students, faculty, staff and visiting guests, even beyond normal working hours to promote self-study, competition, innovation, creativity, self-confidence and nurture their hidden talent to enable students to make optimum use of their potential and shape as responsible citizens. The students are encouraged to study, analyze and understand their emotions, mind, thoughts and the consequences of their own actions. Students are our ambassadors and as an excellent alumni are considered to be a great asset.

CONNECTIVITY

The University is about 12 Km south of holy town of Katra and is about 40 Km north of Jammu, the winter capital of J&K, overlooking Jammu- Srinagar national highway (NH-1A). Jammu is accessible through road, rail and air routes. Train connectivity is being extended to Katra Railway Station which is expected to be made operational by the Railways in near future.



Vice Chancellor's Message

Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University (SMVDU) was established by 'Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board' through the SMVD University Act of J&K Legislative Assembly in 1999. This fully residential university started teaching programs in 2004 and is situated just about 12 kms from the holy town of Katra in the Reasi district of Jammu & Kashmir. The University campus with an area of about 430 acres is located on the Katra-Srinagar road in the beautiful surroundings of the hills - one side being the Trikuta hills well known for the holy shrine of Mata Vaishno Devi. The university has excellent infrastructure and provides semi furnished accommodation to all the faculty members as well as staff members in the campus.

SMVDU endeavors to provide excellent education to the students through undergraduate and postgraduate degree programs so as to create finest professionals and human beings. At present, the university offers B.Tech. degree in the fields of Computer Science & Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering and Industrial Biotechnology, and B.Arch. degree. The postgraduate and doctoral programs are offered in all these areas of technology as well as in select sciences, humanities and social sciences viz. Physics, Bio-technology, Mathematics, Management (for MBA degree), Philosophy and English. SMVDU is one of the fastest growing young universities of India, attracting students from over 22 States of the country. The university has a modern world-class auditorium with seating capacity of 1000. All classrooms are fitted with LCD/DLP projectors. Smart boards are available in the Schools (Departments).

SMVDU (campus) was inaugurated by Shri A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, Hon'ble President of India in 2004. The university had the privilege of having **Hon'ble Prime Minister of India** Dr. Manmohan Singh, **Hon'ble President of India** Smt. Pratibha Devisingh Patil and **Hon'ble Vice President of India** Shri Hamid Ansari as the Chief Guest for the Convocation in 2008, 2011 and 2014 respectively. Shri N.R.Narayana Murthy addressed the Convocation as the Chief Guest in 2009. **The guiding spirit of the university is our Chancellor Padma Vibhushan Shri N. N. Vohra, the Chairman of SMVD Shrine Board and Hon'ble Governor of Jammu & Kashmir State.**



SMVD University has been privileged to attract meritorious students who are well mentored by the dedicated faculty.

The University has a Placement Cell which assists students towards getting good placements. All types of sports facilities are provided to the students, including separate Gymnasium for boys and girls in the lush green campus. Medical Aid Centre of the University has three qualified doctors with necessary para-medical staff. A super-specialty hospital which is also a fully funded initiative of Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board is nearing completion adjacent to the University. There is a mini shopping centre, at present which caters to the basic day-to-day needs of the students and all other campus residents.

Faculty and staff of the University are courteous and provide good support to students. At present, there are six hostels which are spaciouly built and a few more hostels are coming up. Dining is provided to the hostel students four times a day (Breakfast, Lunch, Evening Tea & Snacks and Dinner) through established contractor(s) at a well negotiated per day rate. The University receives recurring and non-recurring grants from the SMVD Shrine Board and UGC which subsidizes the education cost at the University. SMVDU is a fully residential University which provides safe, harmonious and pious academic environment for the meritorious students.

Admission Procedure

UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

Admission to Undergraduate B.Tech. & B.Arch. Programmes is made through the Joint Entrance Examination Main (JEE Main). Details about the JEE Main can be obtained from the office of I/c Admissions (Undergraduate) or from the websites (www.jeemain.nic.in, www.smvdu.net.in). Admissions are made through centralized counseling conducted by the Central Seat Allocation Board CSAB (earlier known as CCB) constituted each year by MHRD for the purpose. After completion of the central counseling, if some seats remain vacant, the same may be filled through SMVDU direct counseling from the forms received against the national level advertisement of the University for the purpose. However, such admissions will also be done on the basis of JEE Main All India Rank (AIR) 2014 only.

ELIGIBILITY

B.Arch.: Candidates applying for B. Arch Programme should satisfy the eligibility criteria as per Council of Architecture (CoA) guidelines.

B.Tech.: An applicant should have passed 10+2 examination from a recognized Board. Candidates appearing in the qualifying examination can also apply subject to their passing the qualifying examination before the admissions are finalized.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Self attested copies of following documents should be attached with the application form:

- Character-Certificate from the Head of the Institution, last attended by the applicant or from Gazetted officer in case of break in academic career.
- Date of Birth Certificate.
- Marks-sheet of all the relevant examinations passed.
- 6 recent passport size photographs.
- Two self-addressed (duly stamped) envelopes.
- JEE Main Registration Card, JEE Main Rank Card, valid documents from the admission centre.
- School leaving certificate/ Transfer certificate in original.

Note : Candidates are required to bring all the certificates in original along with them for verification purposes.

UG-cum-PG INTEGRATED DUAL DEGREE PROGRAMME

ELIGIBILITY

B.Sc. (H) & M.Sc. (Economics): 10+2 in any discipline with minimum 60% marks or equivalent CGPA.

Candidates appearing in 10+2 or equivalent examination awaiting results may also apply. Selection will be through merit, i.e. percentage score in 10+2 Board Examination or equivalent OR valid UGAT score (May 2014) conducted by AIMA.

POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

The criteria for admission to all postgraduate programmes are listed on the respective school's sections inside this brochure. Keeping in view the number of applications, etc., individual Faculties/Schools may set a higher eligibility criterion for short listing applicants to be called for test/interview. Candidates appearing in the final year examination can also apply. However, the candidates must finish their final qualifying examination including viva-voce, if any, before the date of registration.

The candidates may apply for Ph.D. admissions in various areas of the following schools:

ELIGIBILITY

A candidate for admission to the **Full Time Ph.D. programme** must have obtained Master's degree in Engineering/Technology/ Sciences /Humanities and Social Sciences in respective discipline or equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 6.75 on a ten point scale OR 60% marks in aggregate (of all the years/semesters) where marks are awarded, of any University established by Law for the time being in force. A candidate applying for admission to full time Ph.D. programme must have qualified National level examination such as UGC NET / CSIR/GATE in concerned discipline or should be sponsored by a reputed organization where he/she is working. However, candidate(s) from Non-Engineering Streams (Sciences /Humanities) who are not NET- qualified may also apply for admission to full time Ph.D. programme for which they may be considered in case of left over seats. However such candidates shall not be entitled for any Assistance-ship from the University.

For admission to **Ph.D. on part time basis**, a candidate must have same minimum academic qualification as required for admission to full time Ph.D. programme. Such part time admission in the Ph.D programme will be subject to submission of "No Objection Certificate" from the employer to the University by the candidate.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO Ph.D. (Full time) SCHOLARS

UGC-NET/GATE qualified Full Time Ph.D. Scholars of SMVDU shall be entitled for an Assistantship of Rs.14,000/- per month for first two years and Rs. 15000/- per month for next one year along with a contingency of Rs. 12,000/- per year for the initial two years and a total of Rs. 25,000/- for the third year or till the time he/she submits the Ph.D. thesis. The Scholar shall be required to render 10 hours per week of academic support for the School/College/ University. This will be outside his/her normal academic work. The assistantship will continue subject to his/her satisfactory academic performance, defined by minimum SGPA of 7.5 in the preceding semester and/or his/her satisfactory performance in the Comprehensive Examinations, research work and discharge of responsibilities assigned under the Assistantship scheme. The maximum period of the Assistantship will be 3 years for the Ph.D. programme extendable by one more year subject to review of performance by the Faculty Research Committee (FRC) of the concerned School and on the approval of the Vice Chancellor.

INTAKE

Intake is only an indicative of maximum number of seats that are offered in all the programmes. However University reserves the right to leave some seats vacant. Decision of the university shall be final and binding.

ACADEMIC SCHEDULE

The academic session of the University consists of two semesters. Generally the first semester starts in the first week of August and the first semester starts in the first week of January. Admissions to all postgraduate programmes are made only at the beginning of the first semester

and candidates must join the programmes at the commencement of the first semester. (Refer to Page 42 for details).

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications are invited from candidates by advertising the Programmes in the leading national and local newspapers every year. Subsequently, application forms and the Admission Brochure can be obtained from select branches of J&K Bank Ltd. Or can be downloaded from the University website (www.smvdu.ac.in) in which case the application should be accompanied by a **DD of Rs. 1100/- drawn in favour of Registrar, SMVD University payable at Katra.**

By the date of registration, the candidate must have appeared in all the examinations including viva-voce, if any; of his/her qualifying degree failing which he/she will not be allowed to register.

Note:

- The Annual Mess Charges of Rs. 24,000/- shall have to be paid separately at the time of Admission/Registration through Demand Draft drawn in favour of Registrar, SMVD University, payable at Jammu/Katra. This figure is provisional and subject to minor change.
- The Annual fee payable including the Hostel Charges shall have to be paid in one lump at the time of Admission through Demand Draft drawn in favour of Registrar, SMVD University, payable at Jammu/Katra.
- The Fee Structure (excluding Mess Charges) is subject to an increase of up to 5% to 10% annually in subsequent years as may be decided by the University authorities.

FEE REFUND RULES

Cancellation of admission shall be governed by the following rules and guidelines:

1. In case a student opts for withdrawal of admission before the first date of registration (as may be indicated in the academic calendar) but not later than the date of closure of admission 100% of the annual tuition fee shall be refunded after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as cancellation charges.
2. In case a student opts for withdrawal of admission one day before 25th of August or the date of closure of admissions, whichever is earlier; 100% of the annual tuition fee shall be refunded after deducting Rs. 1,000/- as cancellation charges.

3. In case a student opts for withdrawal of admission on 25th of August or on the date of closure of admissions whichever is earlier, annual tuition fee shall be non-refundable.

4. No refund (except the security deposit) can be claimed in case of the withdrawal on 25th of August or on the date of closure of admissions; whichever is earlier.

5. Full security deposit shall be refunded irrespective of time of withdrawal but not after one year from the date of admission in case of cancellation. Otherwise security deposit shall be refunded after completion of degree for regular students.

6. Fee Under all the other heads shall be refunded partially or fully depending upon actual duration of stay (on 25th of August or on the date of closure

of admissions; whichever is earlier) on the campus which shall be determined on case to case basis. e.g., hostel rent and mess charges are refundable as per actual stay of the student in the hostel. A room shall be treated as occupied incase the student has been allotted the same in the hostel although the student may not have occupied the same physically. Fee under all such heads except security shall become non-refundable on or after the date of closure of admissions in that Programme/ School/ Faculty.

7. These fee refund rules shall be applicable to fresh admissions at the first semester only. And there shall be no refund, whatsoever, in the subsequent semesters.

8. University shall release amount of refund within a maximum period of three months from the date a student applies for the same. Refund shall not be treated as a matter of right however the same shall be done only after the student applies for the same on a prescribed format and the case is processed as per the rules in vogue. Incase of appearance of any discrepancy or objection that may be raised by the claimant, the decision of Vice Chancellor shall be final and binding. Please note that the date of closure of admission shall be notified on the University website at least one week in advance.

MODE OF FEE PAYMENT

At the time of admission, fee under two heads is required to be submitted in full:

1. Admission Fee (including Annual tuition Fee, Annual Fee, One Time Charges, Hostel Charges & Security Deposit)
2. Mess Charges

The fee is to be paid vide **02 separate Demand Drafts**, each drawn in favour of **“Registrar, SMVDU”** and payable in Jammu/ Katra. The details of the fees are indicated in the Table under the head FEE AND OTHER DUES.

In case the DD is prepared from any branch of J&K bank then it should be payable at J&K Bank, SMVDU branch.

Students can also pay the requisite amount of fee by on-line transfer (NEFT or RTGS)

directly from their respective banks to the following two accounts of **Registrar, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University:**

Scholarships/Assistantships/Awards

SCHOLARSHIPS

Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University (SMVDU) has initiated **Student Merit cum Means Scholarship Scheme (SMMSS)** to inculcate work culture and competitive spirit among the students. SMMSS has been launched for the first time in the state of Jammu & Kashmir by any University at this scale.

Under SMMSS the University provides financial assistance in terms of semester tuition fee waiver, ranging from 10% to 100% on the basis of merit during the semester to the top 10% meritorious students in various professional disciplines.

The Director of the concerned School shall engage the awardees of SMMSS in various activities of the school such as Laboratory/Library related work or Other such work as may be approved for the purpose.

The programme is valid for one semester only and the student will have to remain in the top 10% with a CGPA of not less than 8.5 in order to be eligible for receiving the same in the next semester. The programme is a continuous feature of the varsity's academic curriculum.

Newly admitted students of MBA programme, who secure a minimum CGPA of 75 percentile in their CAT Exam shall only be eligible for the benefit of SMMSS in their 1st Semester.

Newly admitted students of B.Tech. programme who secure a minimum All India Rank of 30000 in JEE (Main) shall only be eligible for the benefits of SMMSS in their 1st semester.

Newly admitted students of B.Arch. programme who secure a minimum All India Rank of 1000 in JEE (Main) shall only be eligible for the benefits of SMMSS in their 1st semester.

All other students admitted to PG courses other than MBA, shall not be eligible for the benefit of SMMSS in their 1st semester.

All continuing students [UG/PG] shall have to secure a minimum CGPA of 8.50 in the preceding semester to become eligible for the award of scholarship under SMMSS scheme for all subsequent semesters.

A student who comes from a very poor background and secures a CGPA of 9.0 and above shall be given 100% assistance. However, applicants of SMMSS under 'Poor Background' shall have to provide proof of their monthly income as on date, so as to ascertain their eligibility under the above scheme. Only, candidates having family gross annual income of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Two Lacs only) or below, shall be considered hailing from 'Poor Background'.

For becoming eligible for assistantship under SMMSS, student awardees shall have to maintain highest CGPA besides no loss of the registered credits to receive the

benefits of the scheme on a continuous basis.

ASSISTANTSHIP FOR M.TECH. STUDENTS

Based on the Valid GATE Score, the top 18 students in each stream of M.Tech. Programme shall be eligible for Assistantship of value Rs. 8,000/- per month (as per current norms).

AWARDS

▪ **Certificate of Distinction-** To be given to eligible graduating students of each year in each degree programme of study in different Schools with a cash prize of Rs. 10000 on the basis of academic & co-curricular parameters.

▪ **Infosys Foundation prize for Excellence -** Cash prize of Rs. 5000 each along with a Certificate to the pass out toppers of each PG Programme of SMVD University as instituted by the Infosys Foundation.

▪ **Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board Gold Medal -** Cash prize of Rs. 50000, a Gold Medal & Certificate to One UG & One PG student funded by SMVD Shrine Board with due weightages for academic & co-curricular/extra curricular activities.

▪ **Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board Medal for Best Girl Student -** This new Medal is to be awarded to the Best Girl Student of the year adjudged on the basis of due weightage for academic & co-curricular / extra curricular activities.



SPATIAL ORGANIZATION

The University campus has been distributed in the following zones along the Shrine Axis:

- I. Residential
- II. Academic
- III. Administrative
- IV. Hostel and
- V. Recreation

RESIDENTIAL ZONE

The residential area is located in the southern most portion of the campus and is provided with a lovely fountain, lawns, gardens and a loop road with flowering trees. The University provides **residential accommodation** to faculty and other employees. The senior faculty and administrative staff are provided with individual houses, while others are housed in two or three bedroom apartments. The club and sports facilities are provided to the employees and their families.

A **Guest House** with VIP catering facility is located in the residential zone to facilitate university guests. The **Girl's Hostels** are also located in this area.

ACADEMIC ZONE

Academic area consists of four main buildings other than **Central Library**, which house four **FACULTIES**, namely, Faculty of Engineering, Faculty of Management, Faculty of Humanities & Social Sciences and Faculty of Sciences, with appropriate spaces for faculty, staff, reference libraries and classrooms etc, surrounded by new academic block with four blocks, which houses class rooms, science laboratories, computer labs and theatres etc. All the buildings are interconnected and have open interactive spaces. Adjacent to these, the building complex for **Central Work Shop** and School of Architecture & Landscape Design are also located.

ADMINISTRATIVE ZONE

The administrative zone lies close to the academic zone and the average walking distance between the academic and residential zones is about five minutes only. The administrative block, located at slight elevation, houses offices for the

Vice Chancellor, Registrar, Finance division and other administrative officers.

A centrally air-conditioned, state of the art **Auditorium** with seating capacity for 1000 persons is also the part of this zone.

HOSTEL ZONE

Boy's hostels with single, double and triple seated accommodation are located along the Shrine Axis so that the walking distance to the schools is about 3 to 5 minutes. Dining facilities managed by the students (Mess Committees) are available in all the hostels.

RECREATION ZONE

The facilities for socio-cultural activities have been provided in the Academic area and the student's hostels. A full fledged Sports Complex with most of the modern facilities is under development.

INFRASTRUCTURE

INTERNET

Network Centre of SMVDU serves the Internet facility in the campus. It covers all Departments, Hostels, Administrative Offices, Medical Aid Centre, Guesthouse, and faculty residences.

SMVD UnivNET (SMVDU University Network) has been designed using Cisco Switches, Network Management System, L3 Switch and Pix Firewalls. Internet services are provided from two Internet Service Providers viz. Reliance and BSNL. With the endeavor of Network Centre team, SMVDU is now a part of NKN (National Knowledge Network) connecting all Universities in India including IIT, IISc, NIT, etc.

Uninterrupted Internet facilities have been provided in SMVDU campus with 60 Mbps internet leased line connectivity from Reliance Communications. Also, 1 GBps Internet leased line link from BSNL under NMEICT (National Mission on Education through Information & Communication Technology) programme is also successfully commissioned.

Virtual Classroom facility under NMEICT is being successfully conducted using AVIEW. Thus, providing online teaching to the students of SMVDU by the Professors from IIT's, IISc's etc. Online course module for students of SMVDU is underway which after completion, acts as a central repository for all curriculums of Engineering and Sciences stream encompassing the modules developed under NPTEL, MIT, etc.

POWER SUPPLY

University has 33KV substation on the campus to ensure uninterrupted power supply to all the parts of the campus. As the result of this there is no shortage or curtailment of the power on the campus. The University also has uninterrupted power back (UPS), wherever required, with the help of high power generator and inverters.

WATER SUPPLY

The University has a dug well with a provision of pumping and storing 1,00,000 gallons

of potable water in the campus daily which is checked regularly for quality.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS

To facilitate the telecommunication needs, University had installed latest 4000 V2.0E simplex IP ready Siemens communication server. Through, 456 Analog Extension's (Expandable up to 1392 Extensions), 24 Digital Extensions, 32 trunk lines with CLIP facility on each extension. Locking/unlocking, DND, calls Pickup, Call forwarding, Polarity Reversal; add on conference (3-Party), the EPBAX system is providing 24x7 telecommunication services in SMVDU campus.



LIBRARY

SMVD University has a **CENTRAL LIBRARY** which is a specialized technical library. Various sections of the Central Library are Acquisition Section, Technical Section, Circulation Section, Reference Section, Periodical Section, Computer Section, Reading Section, Photocopy Section and Education@UK Centre.

The Central Library collection encompasses Management, Economics, Engineering, Architecture, Sciences, Philosophy, Culture, Religion, English, Dogri & Hindi Literature.

All the students and employees of the University are eligible for membership of the library. The registered members are issued bar-coded library identity cards. The category of library members are Students; Faculty members; Staff members, and Research Scholars.

The library is equipped with an Integrated Library Management software package - the LIBSYS - with all the modules for the library housekeeping operations. Users can find the latest editions of books and periodicals in the library, status of books (issued/on-shelf) and can check the account overdue against the borrower. Using **LIBSYS OPAC(Online Public Access Catalogue)**, users can search the Library Online Catalogue by Author, Title, Subject, and Keywords. One can also search or check the same on Internet through **WebOPAC** with the help of **LSPremia** (the web-enabled LIBSYS) software.

Library catalogue is automated and fully indexed. The catalogue can be browsed and searched by author, titles, and subject/keywords. The entire Library collection is **Bar-coded**. The Bar-coded Library cards are

issued to the members in order to avail the library facilities.

Library also provides access to its users to online periodicals & various information resources through internet enabled computer room. Also Virtual digital Library through university webpage, gives access various online reference resources including Open Access Journals. Users can access CD-ROM titles through **SMVDU-INTRANET**.

Reprographic facilities are also available within the Library premises. Library also provides Current Awareness Services & is involved in Selective Dissemination of Information.

In order to get books on loan basis or journal reprints on request is possible through

DELNET (Developing Library Network), Delhi. We procure books on request through Inter-library Loan (ILL) from the DELNET. One can also find out the books or journals available in various libraries in India with the help of Union Catalogue of DELNET.

Library is also a member of **INDEST-AICTE Consortium** for subscribing to access all the online journals in the field of Engineering, Management and Sciences. Through INDEST Consortium Library has access to various publisher journals.



Academic Resource & Support Systems

TRAINING & PLACEMENT

University has a full fledged Training & Placement cell consisting of Chairman Placements, Vice Chairman Placements, Faculty Coordinators, Student Coordinators, and a T&P Officer. The Training & Placement Cell assists in Summer Training and Campus Placements for the graduating students at SMVDU. Training & Placement Officials and the Volunteers provide possible assistance to the recruiters for Pre-placement Discussions, conducting Tests & Interviews and Hospitality of the Campus hiring Team. The hospitality and the functioning of the Placement Cell at SMVDU is applauded and well received by the visiting recruiters every year.

HEALTH CARE

The University **Medical Aid Centre** provides medical services to all the employees and students of the University. Independent premises of Medical Aid Centre extends following facilities for the health care of residents:

OPD: Services are available to all the inhabitants of the University, nearby villages, CRPF Camp Personals and DPS students.

LABORATORY: A well equipped clinical laboratory with Semi Auto Analyzer is functional in Medical Aid Centre.

AMBULANCE SERVICE: Ambulance is available for referring the patients to GMC Jammu/ ASCOMS Sidhra/ CHC Katra hospital in case of emergency.

IMMUNISATION: Under Border Cluster scheme, on every fourth Wednesday of the month, a team of qualified personals of Health Department visit

the campus to provide free of cost immunization.

CHEMIST: A well stocked and 24 hours open Chemist shop is situated next to Medical Aid centre.

WARD: Separate wards for male and female indoor patients.

HOSTELS

Office of Dean of Students is responsible for Hostel administration, welfare, conduct, discipline, health of students, fee concessions as well as helping students to build their personality and making their stay comfortable on the campus. **Separate Boys' & Girls' Hostels** are provided for the comfortable stay. Hostel affairs are managed through the participative approach by the warden under the overall guidance of the Dean of Students.

Various Hostel committees are responsible for smooth, healthy and active pattern of life in each hostel. **Hostel Rules & other details are provided in Hostel Residents Guide Book**. The **catering services** for the students, faculty and staff have been outsourced and are being rendered by a contractor in the boy's and girl's hostels, besides this wet canteens and cafe are also located on the campus.



Extra Curricular Activities

SPORTS & CULTURAL

The office of the Dean of Students facilitates and encourages the students to participate in various cultural activities. The major activities are charted in a Cultural Calendar as per the academic session. The activities are coordinated by a faculty-in-charge called Cultural Coordinator. The Cultural Coordinator is assisted by the Cultural Secretaries elected by the members of the Council of Students' Affairs.

The Department promotes competitive sports and games activities within the campus. The University has facilities such as **Multi-purpose Gym, Badminton Courts, Volleyball Courts, Basketball Courts, Tennis Courts, Football Ground, Cricket Ground, Kho-Kho Field, Kabbadi Field and Athletic Tracks and Field.**

In order to welcome the new students and in search for their extra-curricular talents, a cultural event called **CONCORDANCE** is organized in the beginning of every academic session in August. It is followed by **TITIKSHA**, the technical festival, **TATTVA**, the management festival, **LITLIFE**, the literary festival, and **SRIJAN**, the architecture festival. The University organizes its annual cultural and sports festival called **RESURGENCE** in which the students from various Universities/Institutions are also invited to participate and compete.

To engage the students in various extra-curricular activities, a House system is introduced. All the students across discipline are grouped into five Houses named Aakash, Agni, Jal, Prithvi, and Vayu. Such a system of classification occasions cross-disciplinary interactions among the students coming from diverse cultural backgrounds. This is also to inculcate the spirit of team work and to encourage a sense of healthy competitiveness among the students.

There are various Clubs such as Music Club, Dance Club, Dramatics Club, Quiz Club, Film & Photography Club, Literary Club, Debate Club, Adventure Club, Fine Arts Club, Hindi Club, OSUM Club and Book Club through which the students pursue and sharpen their extra-curricular talents. The Mind Meet Forum is constituted to organize panel discussions and lectures on relevant issues to create awareness among the students regarding the burning issues of national and international importance.

Moreover, the Dean of Students office organizes various workshops, lectures, inspirational talks for the benefit of the students. The faculty members are engaged in regular counseling and guidance of the students for the development of their communication and argumentative skills. The students are provided with travel allowance and other necessary kits for their participation in cultural and sports activities organized by other Universities / Institutions across country.



Extra Curricular Activities

PUBLICATIONS

The University policies encourage student participation in bringing out publications in which students play a vital role. Apart from faculty members, students members are also included in the publication committee so that they are fully involved in bringing out various publications and organizing events for nurturing the literary and journalistic talent of the student community.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

The University has initiated NSS activities since its inception. In this direction during the National Science Day Celebrations at the University, special care is taken to involve school children from the neighborhood. On this occasion they are exposed to many aspects of scientific and social awareness Science talent search programme was launched on NSD, 2006 in the schools in the vicinity of the University. Competitions among the students from these schools are organized.

Activities like blood donation camps, AIDS awareness campaigns, and academic initiatives are being conceptualized. NSS volunteers also work on behalf of National Foundation for Communal Harmony, an autonomous charitable organization under the Home Ministry, GOI.

Summer camps / Adventure camps for the Students of SMVDU are held which have a special focus on helping them understand and execute their social duties and responsibilities.

All undergraduate students are required to enroll for NSS in the first year. This requirement should be completed in one year. If, however, a student is not able to complete this requirement in the first year, he/she must complete it by the end of the 2nd year (4th semester).



PROHIBITION OF RAGGING

A student shall conform to a high standard of discipline and shall conduct himself/herself, within and outside the premises of the University, in a manner befitting the students of University. He/she shall have the seriousness of purpose and shall in every way, train himself/herself to lead a life of earnest endeavor and cooperation.

He/she shall show due courtesy and consideration to the employees of the University and Halls of Residence, good neighborliness to his/her fellow students, respect to the Wardens of the Halls of Residence and the teachers of the University and pay due attention and courtesy to visitors.

RAGGING IN ANY FORM IS BANNED IN SMVD UNIVERSITY.

The University treats ragging as a cognizable offence and stern action will be taken against the offenders. To safeguard ideals of scholarship, character and personal behaviour, the University reserves the right of withdrawal/expulsion of any student at any time for any reason deemed sufficient.

Ragging of any kind and of any manner is strictly prohibited as per order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Any body found involved in an act of intimidation /abuse to a fresh student is liable to be prosecuted/restricted under law.

GENDER SENSITIZATION COMMITTEE AGAINST SEXUAL HARASSMENT (GSCASH)

Shri Mata Vaishno Devi University endeavors to provide an environment free of sexual harassment, intimidation or exploitation, and has constituted Gender Sensitization Committee Against Sexual Harassment (GSCASH), as per UGC norms, to address gender related issues in accordance with the guidelines laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in this regard. The meeting of GSCASH is held periodically and highest priority is accorded to gender-sensitive matters. Besides, the GSCASH also organizes programs for Gender sensitization through Workshops, Seminars, Posters, Film Shows, Debates, Skits etc. at the University.

HONOUR CODE

In order to promote ethical behaviour, the University requires every student to agree to abide by the Honour Code. At the time of admission, every student has to sign the Honour Code and submit a copy to the respective academic section. Violations of this Code are taken very seriously and may result in suspension or expulsion.
