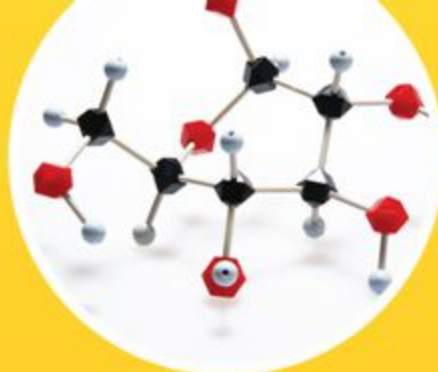

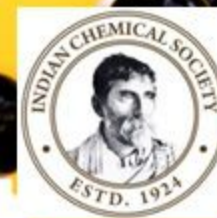

## Dept. of Chemistry...

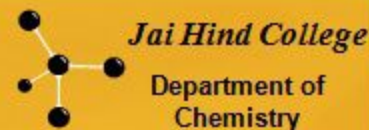

## The RSM...

Jai Hind College is proud to collaborate with Indian Chemical Society (Mumbai Branch) for its 30<sup>th</sup> Research Scholars' Meet. RSM is an important annual event of the ICS which provides a platform to researchers to present their work and deliberate with a distinguished gathering of experts in the field consisting of senior academic faculty/scientists from BARC, IIT, TIFR, ICT, research guides from University of Mumbai, Deemed Universities, other academic institutes and industries in Mumbai region. Students pursuing their doctoral studies can present their work to get feedback on work done and gain valuable insights on the road map ahead leading to the award of their doctoral degrees.

The RSM has traditionally been open to students pursuing their doctoral studies. The RSM 2018 however, also **additionally calls for poster presentations from PG students** (by papers & by research) on their own research work carried out during their masters program. The ICSMB strongly believes that it will benefit PG students of chemistry to develop a research aptitude.



## Call for abstracts...

The RSM 2018 calls for abstracts for paper presentation from doctoral students forwarded through research supervisors reflecting on the content of the Ph.D work. A student who has completed at least two years of research from the date of his/her registration will be considered for presentation at RSM 2018. Those with less than two years of research work can participate in the event (without presentation).



The RSM 2018 also calls for abstracts for poster presentation from PG students. Students pursuing M.Sc. program at University, affiliated colleges or deemed/autonomous universities/ colleges in Mumbai who have finished 1 year of masters program are eligible to present their ingenious research work as a poster of size 4ft (height) x 3.2 ft (width) which has been carried out under the guidance of a research supervisor who is a permanent and approved faculty member of the University of Mumbai.

The abstracts for paper/poster presentations should be limited to 300 words and must highlight the research work. It should bear the name of the research scholar (presenting author only) and of the research guide(s) (compulsory). Please use word processor (MS Word) with the following settings: A4 size (11.69" x 8.27"); margins of 1.5" on left and 1" on all other sides; font Times New Roman; line spacing 1.5 lines & spacing after para 6 pt; line1: title in capital, bold and in 14 point font size; line2: author's name (underlined) & name of research guide (asterisk); line3: email ids; line4: name of affiliated institution; line7: body of abstract in font size 12; keywords (maximum 6) to be mentioned at the end of the body; references (2) have to be included in the following pattern: *Singh A.B.; Marathe C.D.; J Polym. Sci., 3, (28-36), 2005.*

For oral presentations, the topic of the thesis and the Ph.D. registration number with date should be given as a foot note in the abstract.

The abstracts will be subject to review and will be accepted on the basis of the technical contents. Authors will be informed about acceptance by mail. It is mandatory for the concerned research supervisor to be available at the time of presentation.
